

- **Keyworkers and Vulnerable Child Survey**

- Dear Parent and Carers

This form only needs to be completed by those who are 'Key Workers' as defined below, and/or have a 'Vulnerable Child' as also defined below.

The government has asked parents to keep their children at home, wherever possible, and asked schools to remain open only for those children who absolutely need to attend. It is important to underline that schools, colleges and other educational establishments remain safe places for children. But the fewer children making the journey to school, and the fewer children in educational settings, the lower the risk that the virus can spread and infect vulnerable individuals in wider society.

Schools are, therefore, being asked to continue to provide care for a limited number of children - children who are vulnerable and children whose parents are critical to the Covid-19 response and cannot be safely cared for at home.

Vulnerable children include children who are supported by social care, those with safeguarding and welfare needs, including child in need plans, on child protection plans, 'looked after' children, young carers, disabled children and those with education, health and care (EHC) plans.

Further to my letter, please can you advise the school by completing the form below which 'Key Worker' sector applies to you and if so, whether you require school based provision for your child as defined by the Government OR if your child falls in to the category of 'Vulnerable Child'.

This will allow us to assess the level of need and plan accordingly. I will then send out a further communication to you as required.

Please respond by 12pm on Friday 20th March.

If you do not respond by **12pm today** and are a key worker or have a vulnerable child as detailed by the Government, I will need to assume that you do not require school based provision.
