

Using Sessaw

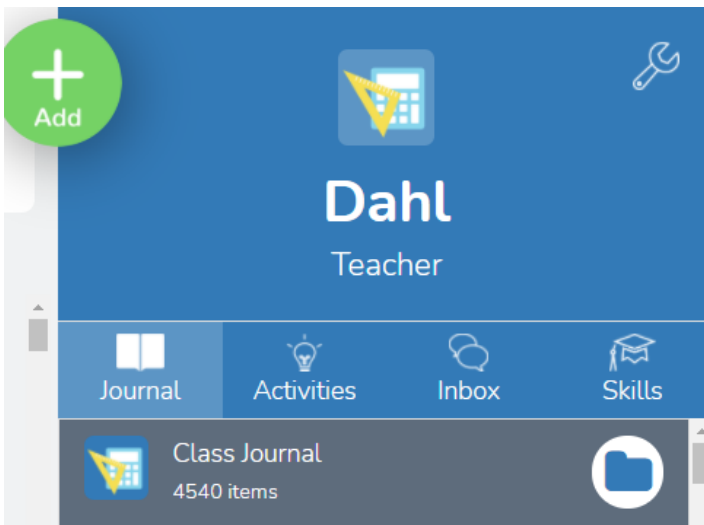
Visit: app.seesaw.me on the web browser (google chrome works well)

Click 'I'm a student'

Use the TEXT CODE: On your child's home learning code page provided to you.
It is a string of 16 letters




Once you are logged in, you will see the child's journal. On the right hand side you will see the following options:



Click on the activities tab, to see what activities there are to complete. (it may have a red notification number to indicate how many activities there are)

Once on the activities page, the activities will come up as shown:

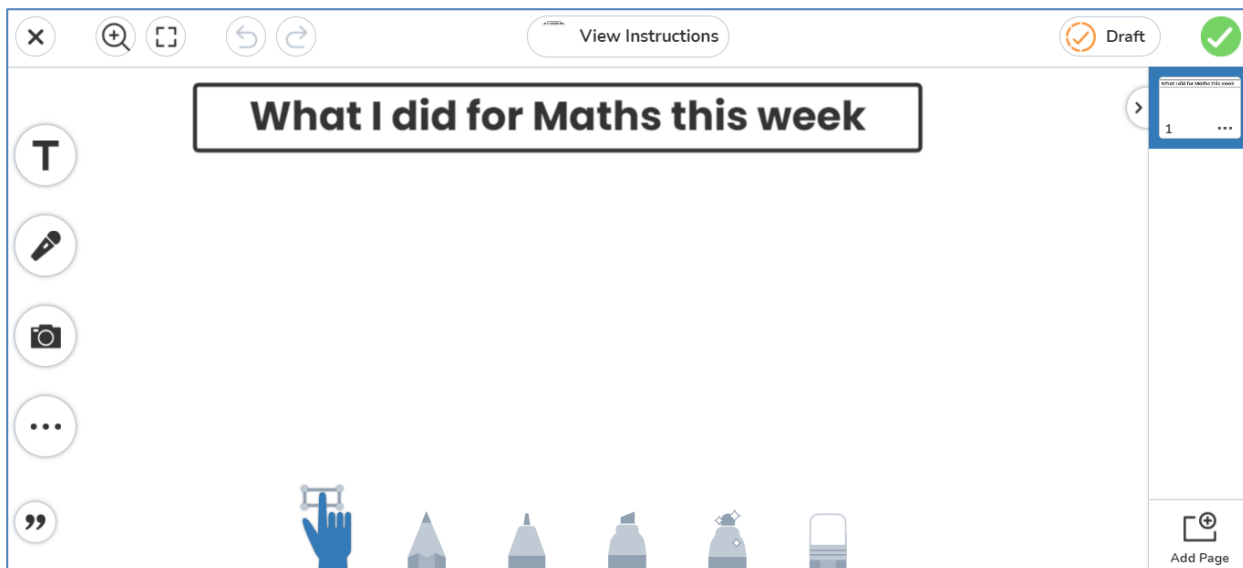


To complete the activity, first read the instructions and follow any links provided.

Then click the button

This will either take you to a set template, or give you an option to choose how you want to respond to the activity.

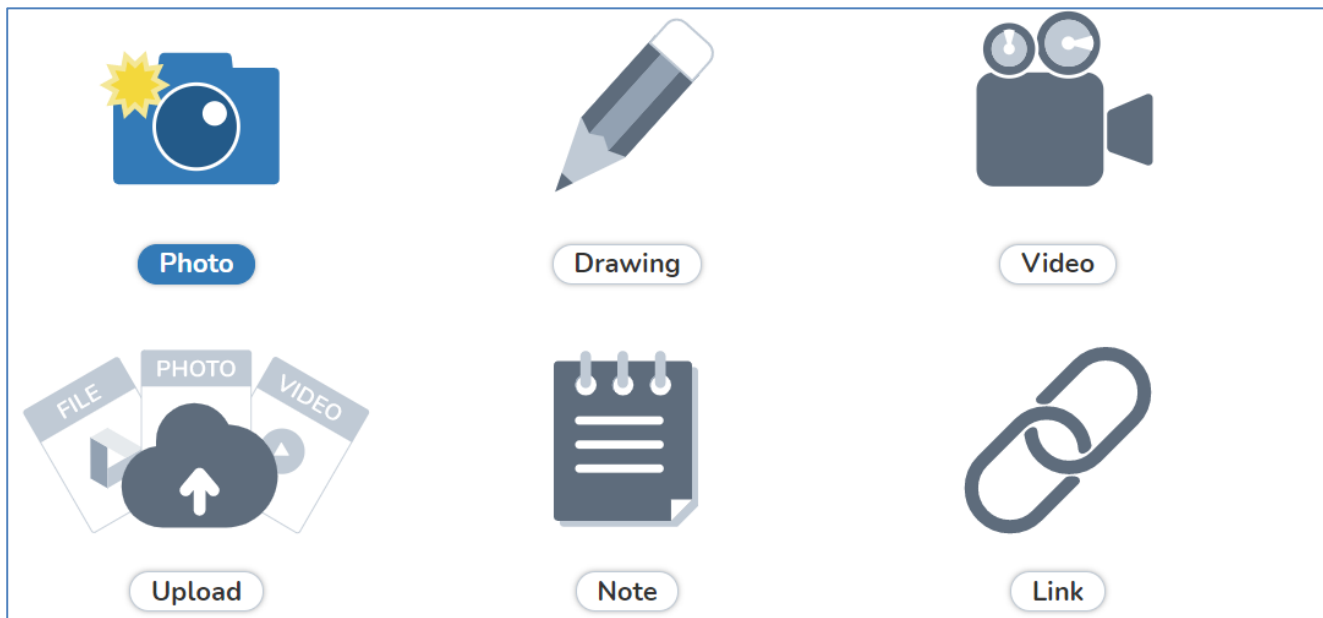
A set template might look like this:
