The Foundation Stage Profile

Listening & Attention

30 - 50 Months	19	Listens to others one to one or in small groups, when conversation interests them.	
	20	Listens to stories with increasing attention and recall.	
	21	Joins in with repeated refrains and anticipates key events and phrases in rhymes and stories.	
	22	Focusing attention – still listen or do, but can shift own attention.	
	23	Is able to follow directions (if not intently focused on own choice of activity).	
40 - 60+ Months	24	Maintains attention, concentrates and sits quietly during appropriate activity.	
	25	Two-channelled attention – can listen and do for short span.	
ELG	26	Children listen attentively in a range of situations.	
	27	They listen to stories, accurately anticipating key events and respond to what they hear with relevant comments, questions or actions.	
	28	They give their attention to what others say and respond appropriately, while engaged in another activity.	
Exceeding	29	Children listen to instructions and follow them accurately asking for clarification if necessary.	
	30	They listen attentively with sustained concentration to follow a story without pictures or props.	
	31	They can listen in a larger group, for example, at assembly.

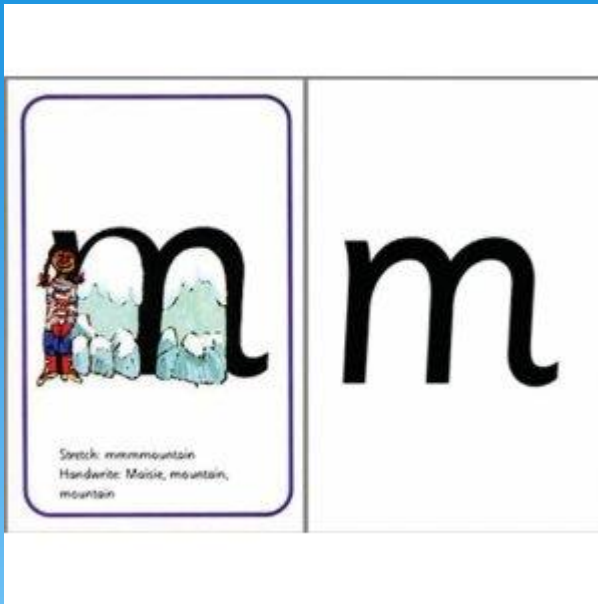

Speed sounds – set 1,2 + 3

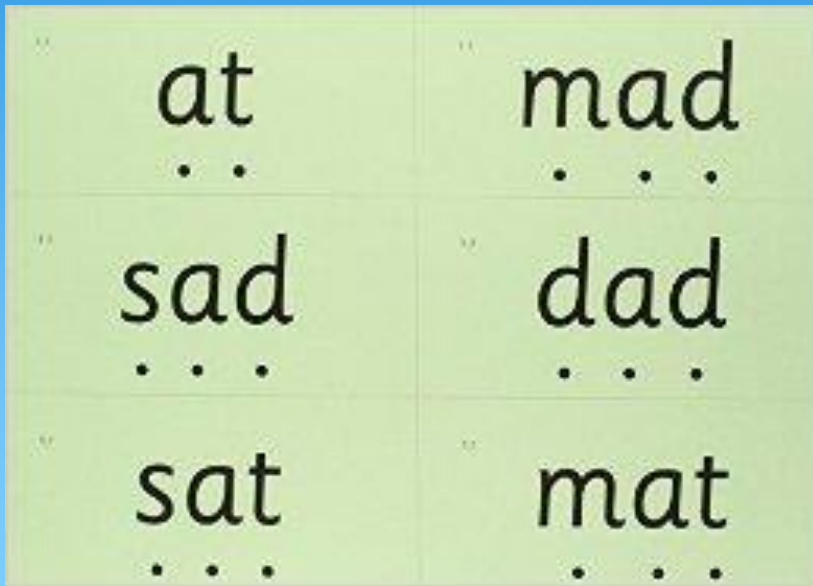
