The following government guidance would be followed in the event of an outbreak –

- 5 children, pupils, students or staff, who are likely to have mixed closely, test positive for COVID-19 within a 10-day period; or 19
- 10% of children, pupils, students or staff who are likely to have mixed closely test positive for COVID-19 within a 10-day period

If advised to reintroduce any measures to break the chains of transmission, the club would –

- Liaise with the head teacher and governors of the school
- Inform parents of the outbreak and measures that will be in place
- If advised, temporary wearing of face masks in communal areas
- Asymptomatic testing twice weekly
- Shielding may be reintroduced if advised
- Continue with good hand hygiene practices, cleaning contact points with D10 and good ventilation
- Reintroduce pods and bubbles of children (EYFS – foundation stage, Year 1.2 in the mobile, Year 3.4 – shared area and Year 5.6 – shared area) A new family pod for breakfast sessions may be needed which would use the green room
- Allocated outdoor zones
- If advised, reduce the number of children in pods
- Organise staff to work in designated area
- PPE and First Aid supplies in all pods
- Revert back to the breakfast bags and individually packaged food items
- New registers made and inform all class teachers
- Update the risk assessment
- Reorganise tables, individual folders and colouring pens
- Indoor and outdoor resource box for each pod
